Education for Parenting Ministry

List of Parenting Centers and Programs

These programs provide vocational nurturing and support for parents raising children in our Catholic faith. *Education for Parenting* workshops and meetings provide a spiritual and faith perspective, age-appropriate behavior information, discipline and communication skills, and a Catholic parenting support network.

Listed below are programs in parishes which offer on-going Education for Parenting throughout the academic year. Other parishes throughout the ten counties of the Archdiocese (*Staten Island, Manhattan, Bronx, Westchester, Putnam, Dutchess, Rockland, Orange, Ulster and Sullivan*) sporadically offer one-session parenting workshops. Here there are descriptions of the on-going Education for Parenting meetings, grouped geographically, by New York City borough and then upstate county locations.

Information about the standing programs described here can change without immediate notice to the Education for Parenting Coordinator in this office/website. One must check with the leaders before attending. In some parishes groups meet on several days a week, in others there is just one weekly meeting, others meet monthly. Dates, days of the week, times, and room locations are all subject to change. Please proceed by calling the parish, inquire about how to get in touch with the Parenting Ministry Director or Leader, who can then give you correct information about meeting room locations, times, etc., and answer your questions.

Fees for all programs vary from parish to parish because of the different types of programs and workshops, their duration, and whether crafts are included at the daytime meetings. Leaders should be consulted to learn about the fee, which is sometimes collected session by session or per semester for daytime programs, or collected in advance for multiple-session evening workshops. If a family cannot afford the fee, it can be adjusted or alternate arrangements can be made. Lack of money need not prevent anyone from participating.
